

5-minute setup for a SEN reading group

the routine

- Minute 1: each pupil opens Wobble on their own device.
- Minute 2: choose tint, font size, line spacing. Save.
- Minute 3: turn on the Reading ruler. Demo a single line.
- Minute 4: turn on Tap-a-word. Each pupil taps one word.
- Minute 5: pick the day's text (Books, Scan, or Photo) and start.

during the session

- Let pupils control playback. Pause is more useful than play.
- Encourage one tap per page on a tricky word, no more. Reading is the priority.
- If the group reads the same chapter, agree on one voice cast so everyone hears the same characters.

after the session

- Ask each pupil to name one word they tapped and what it meant.
- Note any settings the pupil changed mid-session, this is useful data for IEPs.

differentiation tips

- Beginning reader: Photo mode + single voice + larger font.
- Confident reader who loses their place: Books + Reading ruler ON.
- ESL reader: Tap-a-word + slower playback speed.
