

Who's who: character cards mid-read

what it does

Wobble already generates a cast list for every book. The Who's who panel pulls that list up mid-read, so a student can remind themselves who someone is without leaving the page or losing the line.

when it helps

- Books with lots of named characters (fantasy, classic novels, plays).
- Stories where a character has not appeared for a few chapters.
- Group reading: pupils can quickly check pronunciation of a name.

how to open it

- While reading, tap the Who's who button in the reader toolbar.
- A panel slides up showing each character: name, role, and a one-line description.
- Tap a character to hear the name read aloud in the voice Wobble uses for them.
- Tap outside the panel to close it. Your place is kept.

for teachers

- Use the cast list as a pre-reading activity. Print it (long-press, save) and have pupils predict relationships before they start.
- After a chapter, ask pupils to add their own one-line description for each character. Compare with Wobble's.

Cast lists are generated from the book text only. No student data is sent or stored.
